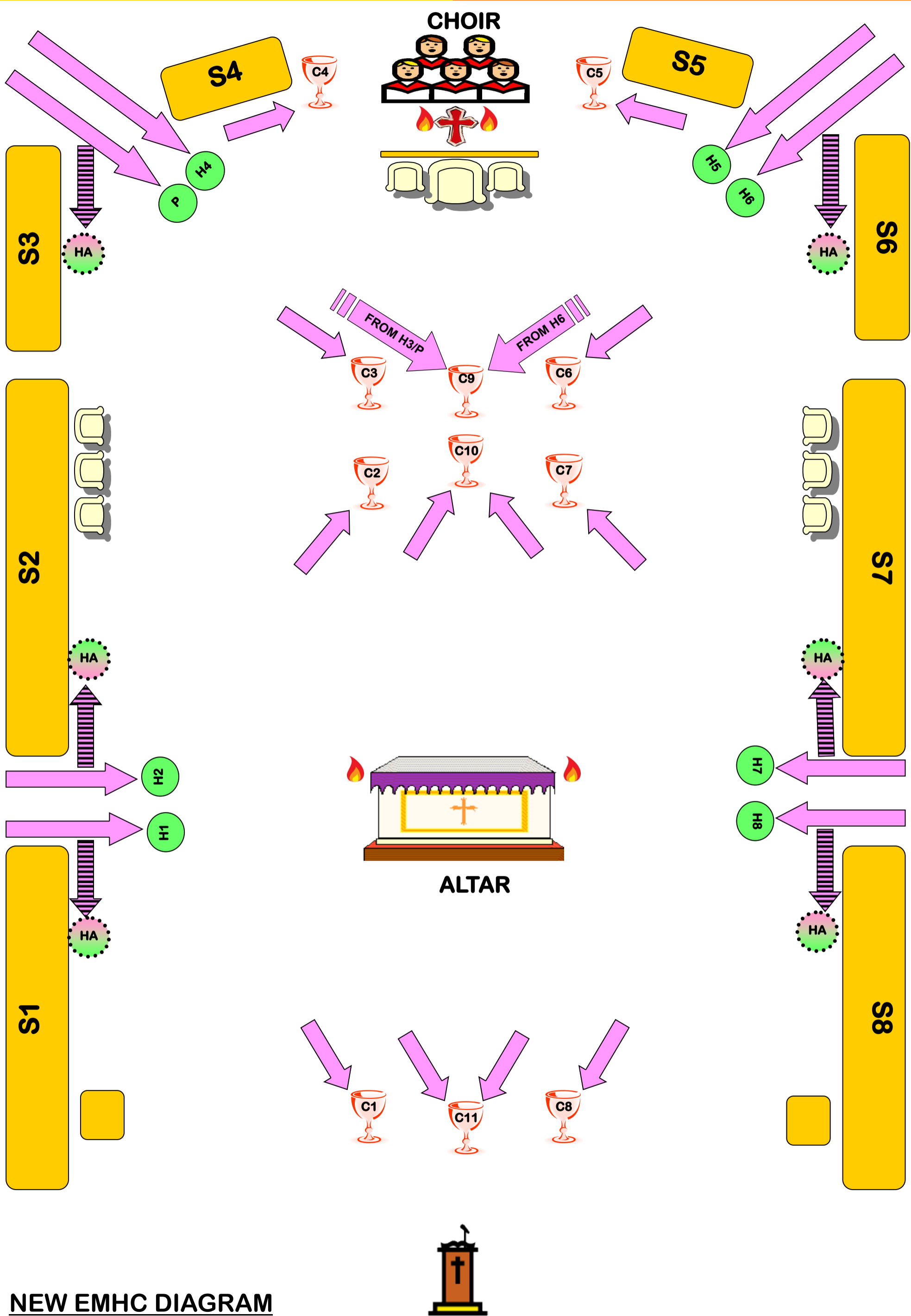


EMHC Stations

On the accompanying diagram of EMHC stations, please note the following changes

- Altar server chairs will be moved permanently to Sections 2 and 7 to make room for better Communion flow.
- When a host minister has completed serving her/his line, s/he should then move and begin serving at one of the Alternative Host positions (HA on the diagram) if any of the remaining lines is sufficiently long. Priority should be given to the HA position near H3 where the priest serves because that line is often the last one to finish.
- H1 through H8 ministers should stand further back into the sanctuary to permit room for communicants to form lines to the HA stations.
- Three new cup positions (C9, C10, and C11) are available for larger Masses (e.g., 9:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m., and 2 p.m.). Ministers in these positions can serve communicants coming from either side of the church.
- The priest will leave the empty ciborium open on the center corporal on the altar during Communion. If a host minister returns to the altar before the priest or deacon, s/he can pour her/his remaining hosts into the ciborium before placing the bowl into the tray for bowls.
